For more than 30 years, Donna has dedicated her skills in the service of teaching and developing the artistic talents of gymnasts with her StyleRope™. She is an author of the children's book, "Where the Gymnast Begins," and the world she has created through the book's story is feeding orphans in Bolivia, India, and Africa.

As a leading choreographer & professional, Donna is known for her captivating routines at the club-level, as well as choreography for National Team members from Europe and the United States. On the collegiate scene, her choreography has been performed for three top-universities: University of Oklahoma, University of North Carolina (Chapel Hill) & University of Missouri. Donna is delighted to offer her artistic skills to the Gimnastica de Rithmica in the town of Carmona (Sevilla), in southern Spain. Donna is also one of few choreographers who has worked with Francis Ford Coppola and Tom Cruise and Rob Lowe in film.
